

## **COOKIES POLICY**

Cookies are small text files that are stored on your computer when you visit a web page. They can have many purposes, and among other things may be used to store your preferences, keep you logged into a website, or to collect visitor statistics – e.g. finding out how many users viewed the site and the pages they accessed. You can set your browser to refuse all or some browser cookies, or to alert you when websites set or access cookies. If you disable or refuse cookies, please note that some parts of this website may become inaccessible or not function properly.

## There are two types of cookies:

Session (Transient) cookies: These cookies are erased when you close your browser, and do not collect information from your computer. They typically store information in the form of a session identification that does not personally identify the user.

Persistent (Permanent or Stored) cookies: These cookies are stored on your hard drive until they expire (i.e. they are based on a set expiration date) or until you delete them. These cookies are used to collect identifying information about the user, such as Web surfing behaviour or user preferences for a specific site.

Take a look at the table below to view which cookies are on our website:

Cookie Name	Life Span	Purpose
svSession	Persistent	Identifies unique visitors and tracks a visitor's sessions on a site.
hs	Session	Security
XSRF-TOKEN	Persistent	Security
smSession	Persistent (Two weeks)	Identifies logged in site members
TSxxxxxxxx (where x is replaced with a random series of numbers and letters)	Persistent	Security
TSxxxxxxxx_d (where x is replaced with a random series of numbers and letters)	Persistent	Security
